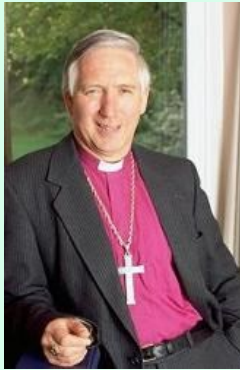

WHEN HEALING LEADS TO DELIVERANCE MINISTRY

Aims of the course

- To develop a better understanding of spiritual evil and how it can be dealt with
- To become aware of possible indications that evil is present
- To understand our limits and when we need professional help

About the Course

Christian prayer for healing often brings its ministers face to face with situations in people's lives when a destructive pattern will not shift through healing prayer. Questions are then raised as to whether or not a deeper reality may be present.

The talks will illustrate how evil realities can be present, and how they can be dealt with through the authority Christ has given us.

This ministry need particular wisdom and care and those who come on this weekend should do so because they firmly believe that Christ is calling them to a better understanding of this particular aspect of healing.

The weekend is not suitable for those who are receiving counselling therapy or psychiatric help.

Who is it for?

The course is for those who have already explored the practice of healing ministry by attending one of Bishop Graham's Learning Healing Ministry weekends or courses. Their participation must be supported by their church minister whose signature is required. This is to ensure that the development of personal ministry takes place under the authority of the local church.

Participants must commit themselves to the whole programme.
